- By entering the competition applicants agree to allow the judges access to view their garden during business hours, upon appointment, and to open their garden to the public from 8.30am - 4.30pm Wed - Sun, 4-8 September 2024. Entry to the Lockyer Valley Garden Competition is free.
- All entries must be based in the Lockyer Valley Regional Council (LVRC) Local Government Area.
- Gardens belonging to judges, sponsors, elected members, council staff, or their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- All prizes are awarded at the discretion of the judges, whose decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- At the judges' discretion entries may be judged in categories other than the one entered.
- Garden owners agree to allow their gardens to be photographed by a nominated person from the LVRC. Photographs may be reproduced in LVRC promotional material to be used by Council at its discretion.
- If requested, a successful applicant will also be available for publicity purposes either in the local media or in a Council publication or other promotional material.
- LVRC, nor the parties involved, will accept any responsibility or will be liable for any injury, loss or damage to an entrant's property as a result of participation in the Lockyer Valley Garden Competition.
- LVRC will not be liable for, or indemnify you against or respond to, any claims made for damage or injury suffered by you or a third party while participating in the Lockyer Valley Garden Competition. You should seek your own advice regarding your insurance position, and it is recommended that you notify your own insurer of your intention to participate in the scheme.

Best Business / School / Commercial Garden - (Includes gardens professionally maintained). Can be of any size, and include places of worship, hospitals, industrial properties, businesses, nursing homes, schools, community areas, retail premises and hotels.

Best Novice Garden – First time entered garden in any category.

JUDGING

All entries in the 2024 Lockyer Valley Garden Competition will be judged on maintenance, design, intent, natural environment and creativity. Council will contact entrants to confirm their allocated judging time slot for judging.

PRIZES

Category Winner – \$150 Pohlman's Nursery prize voucher.
