2024 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- By entering, applicants agree to open their garden to the public from 8.30am - 4.30pm Friday - Saturday, 6-7 September 2024. Open Garden entry is free.
- All entries must be based in the Lockyer Valley Regional Council (LVRC) Local Government Area.
- Gardens belonging to sponsors, elected members, council staff, or their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- Garden owners agree to allow their gardens to be photographed by a nominated person from the LVRC. Photographs may be reproduced in LVRC promotional material to be used by Council at its discretion.
- If requested, a successful applicant will also be available for publicity purposes either in the local media or in a Council publication or other promotional material.
- LVRC, nor the parties involved, will accept any responsibility or will be liable for any injury, loss, or damage to an entrant's property because of participation as an Open Garden.
- LVRC will not be liable for, or indemnify you against or respond to, any claims made for damage or injury suffered by you or a third party while participating as an Open Garden. You should seek your own advice regarding your insurance position, and it is recommended that you notify your own insurer of your intention to participate in the scheme.
- By signing this entry form you understand and agree to the Lockyer Valley Open Gardens terms and conditions. Unsigned entry forms will not be accepted.
